



Code of Conduct – Parent

SDYSA values the importance of creating an environment centered around Safety, Dignity and Respect, Enjoyment and Development. In creating this environment, parents of players that play on SDYSA member club teams have specific responsibilities and standards to uphold.

Parents of players who are registered to an SDYSA member club are expected to adhere to following:

1. As a parent I provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child, their teammates and other players participating in a practice and/or a game.
2. I will not yell at, harass, intimidate or argue with referees on or off the field.
3. I will not yell at, harass, intimidate or argue with players on the team I am a parent of or the opponent's players.
4. I will not yell at, harass, intimidate or argue with any coaches.
5. I will learn the rules of the sport.
6. I will encourage good sportsmanship through demonstrating positive behaviors such as encouraging and cheering for all players.
7. I will never use profanity.
8. I will abstain from using any form of hate speech.
9. I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
